June	LtRLvl 2 + leading, PH & to Method, Grandsire, Double Oxford
July	WP&S, PH & to Method(T), PH Minor, PB Minor, Ipswich S Minor
August	PH to Method (T), PB Minor, Kent TB Minor, Ipswich S Minor (T)

Learning the Ropes Level 2 Exercises

Rounds (normally & alternate bells at opposite strokes)

Ringing Call Changes (at handstroke and backstroke)

Making Places (at handstroke and backstroke)

Dodging (at handstroke and backstroke)

Mexican Wave

Whole pull, stand and move to the right

Calling Call Changes

- one place up/one place down
- to Queens and back (135246)
- to Titums and back (142536)

Progressive Plain Hunting

Bastow Little Bob Minimus, Bastow Little Bob Doubles

Penultimus Doubles

Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star

From standing each bell rings the number of pulls required to ring the tune and then sets.

6 6 2 2 1 1 2 (the 2 sets at back)

3 3 4 4 5 5 6

2 2 3 3 4 4 5

2 2 3 3 4 4 5

6 6 2 2 1 1 2

3 3 4 4 5 5 6

The only bells that don't have to set at backstroke are the 1, 3 and 4.
